

News about the Christian Civic Outreach in Pekin from Melanie:

Several of us were at Church Women United on March 14. There was an announcement by Gloria Ranney (Greg Ranney's wife) that will affect many of us at Our Savior Lutheran Church.

Christian Civic Outreach has been struggling for several years and they have contacted Pekin Outreach Initiative recently. Arlan (head of CCO) is retiring and CCO is donating their land, building, and contents to POI (effective the end of April, we believe.) As we heard when Greg Ranney visited, POI is currently operating in the basement of the Salvation Army on Derby Street.

Across the street from the Salvation Army is a small church that also has a very large clothing give away (Gloria couldn't remember the name but she thought "New Life" was in the name.) This location cannot get ADA bathrooms to have people enter so they give away clothing out on the sidewalk on Derby Street. Apparently, their church will continue to have worship services on Derby. POI has offered that this "New Life" organization can start utilizing the property at the CCO location (Washington and Capital) when CCO moves out and will be able to continue to distribute all the donations that are in the building.

So in a nutshell, CCO will cease to exist in early May. Pekin Outreach Initiative will be the owners of the property, and the church (New Life) will continue to operate a donation site in CCO's building. Gloria said that there are several churches that donate funds and materials to CCO and she hopes that they, including OSLC, will be contacted soon about the changes. I know in the past many years, OSLC has donated canned goods and materials throughout the year, including and especially, Thanksgiving Food, Mitten Tree, & Souper Bowl. We will find out soon where our donations will be most needed.


